A Letter From the Pastor - Tom Brady's Pajamas

"The vision statement of the Global Methodist Church is: Through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit, the Global Methodist Church envisions multiplying disciples of Jesus Christ throughout the earth who flourish in scriptural holiness as we worship passionately, love extravagantly, and

witness boldly.

I'm going to tell you about Tom Brady's pajamas, and I need you to stay with me here.

Tom Brady—seven-time Super Bowl champion, ageless wonder, man who played professional football into his mid-forties like it was nothing—wore special pajamas. Not just any pajamas, mind you, but bioceramic-infused pajamas. I had to look this up. Apparently, they're embedded with minerals that

are supposed to promote recovery and circulation, which sounds like something a Victorian doctor would prescribe right before suggesting a nice bloodletting.

Brady also used resistance bands instead of weights, planned his training schedule three years in advance down to the hour, and went to bed every night at 8:30 PM like a particularly disciplined third-grader. Everyone thought he was insane. But here's the thing: he won seven Super Bowls. Seven. So really, who's the crazy one—Tom Brady in his magic pajamas, or the rest of us eating Doritos at midnight?

The Global Methodist Church has its own version of bioceramic pajamas, and it's called "scriptural holiness." I know, I know—it sounds like something your great grandmother would needlepoint onto a pillow. But stay with me.

Methodists are supposed to live differently because of what God has done for them. We've been "born again" (John 3), become "new creations" (2 Corinthians 5:17), turned "from darkness to light" (Acts 26:18)—basically, we've undergone a transformation so complete that acting normal afterward would be like Tom Brady deciding to take up smoking and late night Taco Bell binges.

John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, had his own peculiar training regimen: prayer, worship, fellowship, sacraments, Scripture reading, and mission work. People thought he was excessive. They probably would have committed him if they'd known he woke up at 4 AM every day for prayer and devotion. But his methods sparked revivals across England and America, and here we are, centuries later, still benefiting from his disciplined approach to faith.

Scholar David Watson writes:

"Scriptural holiness is the work of God we receive through faith to make us a new creation, freeing us from the power of sin to live as a set-apart people. When God makes us new, we will think, speak, and act differently from the world around us in important ways. We will live as set-apart people. Many will think us strange. They may even regard us with animosity. Yet it has been this way since the church's earliest days. Our calling is not to seek the favor of an unbelieving world, but to love and serve God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—who shares his nature with us and sets us apart to bear witness to his love."

So here's what I want to know: How is Jesus helping you live differently in our darkened world? What new thing is Jesus bringing about in your life today? And please, tell me you're not also wearing bioceramic pajamas!

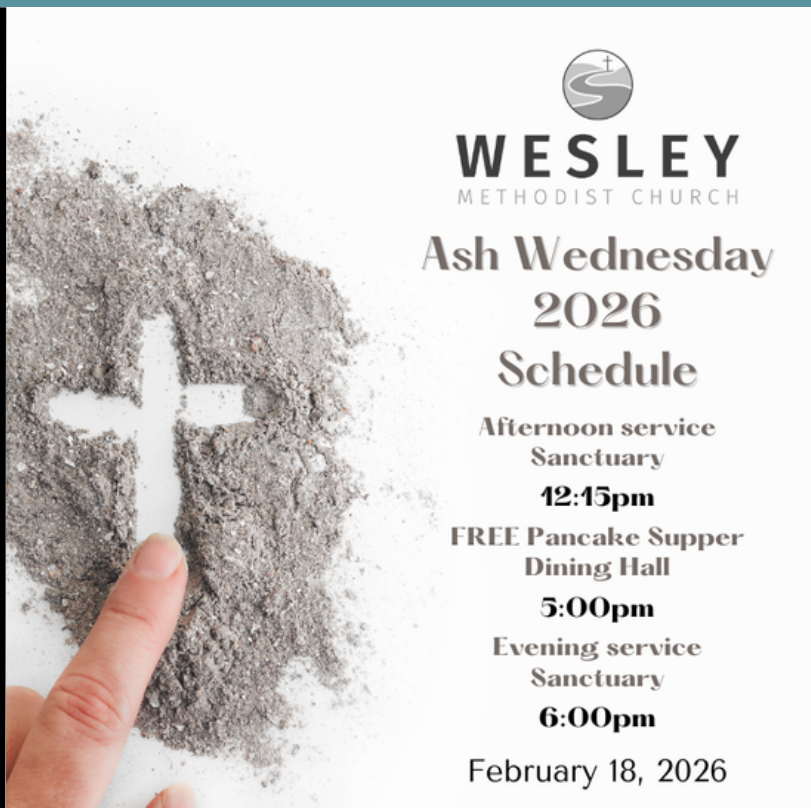
