"Do not remember the former things, or consider the things of old. I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth — do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert."

(Isaiah 43:18–19)

I want to make a small confession. I recently threw away some socks I'd had for over twenty years. I need to make another confession: I was disappointed they hadn't lasted longer. It is hard for me to let go of familiar things — especially when whatever replaces them costs more and matters less.

My socks are nothing compared to what many people are losing right now. Inflation, gas prices that won't hold still, wars, rumors of wars, and a general sense that the ground keeps shifting underfoot. If you feel any of that, you're close to understanding the darkness the people of Israel were living in when they were torn from their homeland and marched through the desert into exile in Babylon.

And yet — into that — God spoke through the prophet Isaiah with a stunning promise: the fact that you cannot see a way forward does not mean one doesn't exist. A path would be made through the wilderness. Rivers would run in the desert.

When we hear news like that — and then watch God actually do it — everything changes. So let me ask: who in your life needs to hear something like that right now? I'll go first. I do. Maybe you do too. That's why we've put together an evening to slow down and listen — for God's voice, for good news, for music that opens something up. We'll worship together, share communion, and have cookies with brothers and sisters from other congregations who are trusting the same God we are.

New paths. Dry ground finding life again. Something new, just now springing forth.
