³⁶ While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' ³⁷ They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. ³⁸ He said to them, 'Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?' Luke 24:36-38

A common response to Jesus' resurrection in the Gospels is fear. People who see him are startled, terrified, and filled with doubt. The Scripture above describes what happened when Jesus appeared to the disciples after the resurrection. They were frightened because this was not at all what they expected. They did not think they would ever see Jesus face to face again.

What do you think it will be like when you see Jesus face to face?

The disciples also had to reckon with their own failures. Judas had betrayed Jesus, Peter had denied him, and all of them had scattered when Jesus was arrested. They were hiding and fearful of what might happen next. So when Jesus appeared, they were not only surprised—they were also weighed down with regret, sadness, and fear of what Jesus might say to them.

Yet Jesus came to show them how deeply they were loved. He was raised, and he invited the disciples to see his hands and feet—and to eat with him once more. They had no reason to fear: Jesus had died for them, God had raised him, and he was now inviting them into new life and renewed fellowship.

Again, what do you think it will be like when you see Jesus face to face? Will it be a moment of joy—or is your heart still troubled and fearful about what that day might be like?

In this season after celebrating the resurrection on Easter Sunday, it's a perfect time to invite Jesus to renovate your heart and life. Ask him to fill you with love, peace, joy, and all the other fruits of the Spirit. Ask him to help you grow into the kind of hope that truly looks forward to seeing him face to face.
