"Sing to the Lord a new song, for he has done marvelous things;...all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God." — Psalm 98:3

There is a popular idea in our society that religion, including Christianity, is in inevitable decline. The common assumption is that younger generations are finding less need for God and faith in their lives.

However, the numbers from credible sources such as the Pew Research Center do not support the narrative we hear too often in our country about Christianity failing or fading away. While it is true that Western Europe and America may see a continued decline in religious affiliation, the world overall will see growth in religions like Christianity and Islam.

The common suggestion that increases in education, scientific innovation, and a better understanding of history remove the need for religion is simply not true. Belief in God makes sense to four out of five people in the world, and that will continue. Why is that? One reason is that a great number of people know there is more to life and existence than what we can take in through our senses and human understanding. Another reason is that secular reasoning has gaps — things missing that are required to live life well. Powerful convictions such as equality, justice, compassion, community, and love are all deeply rooted in beliefs that secular reasoning alone cannot justify.

I hope you see that being a part of the Christian faith and Wesley Methodist is not simply a dwindling attempt to "keep the doors open" or "hold onto the past." It is true that churches practicing selfish individualism — those that are inwardly focused, no matter how polite — will continue to decline and die.

That is why we gather, why we serve, and why we give. Wesley Methodist is not a church holding on — we are a church sent out. The promise still stands: "All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God."
