Matthew 5:20–22 *"For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven... But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment."*

Nassim Nicholas Taleb, a philosopher and risk analyst, built his reputation on a simple but devastating observation: most people do not fail from the big, obvious threats they can see. They fail from the small, invisible vulnerabilities they have been quietly accumulating. In his framework, a fragile system is one that looks stable on the surface but is quietly one shock away from collapse. The fragile person is not the one living recklessly — often, it is the one living comfortably, never noticing the hairline cracks spreading underneath.

Taleb's remedy is not to build thicker walls. It is to remove the hidden sources of ruin before they compound. You do not make a structure strong by adding more weight on top; you make it strong by identifying and eliminating the weak points at the foundation.

This passage from the Sermon on the Mount gives us a wonderful, if challenging, example of Jesus doing exactly that for his disciples. Whether we call them risks or sins, Jesus makes clear that something as terrible as murder rarely appears out of nowhere — it begins with anger, the kind of difficult emotion every one of us faces. He is not simply raising the moral bar; he is pointing his disciples to the hidden source of ruin and saying: deal with it there, before it goes further.

This is the invitation of Lent. We are called in this season to pause, pray, and honestly search our hearts for anything we need to remove — patterns, resentments, habits of mind — that could harm us or others if left unaddressed.

Not more religious performance stacked on top of an already brittle life, but a genuine reckoning with whatever has been quietly accumulating in our spiritual basement, and the courage, with God's help, to deal with it.
