Not long after that, the younger son gathered everything he had, set off for a distant country, and squandered his wealth in wild living. After he had spent everything, a severe famine struck that whole country, and he began to be in need. So he went and hired himself out to a citizen of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. He longed to fill his stomach with the pods the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything. (Luke 15:13-16)

It is said that Thomas Edison conducted over 10,000 failed experiments before successfully inventing the light bulb. When someone told him, "Then you must have wasted your time," Edison replied, "Oh, no — I have not failed 10,000 times. I've successfully found 10,000 ways that will not work."

It did not take the prodigal son 10,000 tries to figure out that what he had been doing wasn't working. He had taken half of everything his father spent a lifetime building, left home, and squandered it on wild living his father never would have approved. He learned quickly that the path he had chosen was a dead end — not the dream destination he had been so certain he could find on his own.

We live in a world still convinced it can do better than what God wants for us. The prodigal son believed that with enough wealth and freedom to do as he pleased, he would find success and happiness. Like so many others, he discovered that without boundaries and wisdom, we too easily find ourselves broke, broken, and desperately in need of help.

The great news of Holy Week is that we can come home — and find forgiveness, reconciliation, and the better way, truth, and life that Jesus offers. If you have been away from the church, now is the perfect time to return. If you are finished trying to do things your own way, now is the time to discover Jesus' way.
